#### What is Title I?

Title I is the largest federally funded program for elementary, middle, and high schools. Through Title I, money is given to school districts around the country based on the number of low-income families in each district. Each district uses its Title I money for extra educational services for children most in need of educational help. The focus of the Title I program is on helping all students meet the same high standards expected of all children.

### Purpose of a Title I Schoolwide Program

The purpose of the schoolwide Title I program is to improve the entire educational program in a school which should result in improving the academic achievement of all students, particularly the lowest achieving students. The goal of such a program is to assist those students to demonstrate proficiency on academic standards.

# How does our school participate in the Title I Program?

- Our school is designated as a Schoolwide Program which means that all students can benefit from Title I funding.
- Our School's Designation Status is a Title I Schoolwide Program.

### Pickens Junior High School Schoolwide Program

#### Our school improvement goals are to:

- During the 18-19 school year, we will establish data for FY18-19 and have a 64% pass rate on the 7th and 8th grade English EOG's
- During the 2018-2019, we will set baseline data to be at or above the state average in students performing at levels 3 and 4 on the Georgia Milestones

#### What programs/supports are in place to help my child?

- After school tutoring in all content areas; reading focused on Tuesday & Thursday
- IXL web based program for Math & English for use in school and at home

# How does our school spend Title I money?

Pickens Junior High School spends Title I funds on resources designed to improve student achievement. These resources include:

- Personnel an academic coach
- Tutoring -- offered in afternoons
- IXL for content areas to be used at school and at home
- Parental involvement activities such as workshops and training
- Print and electronic materials that address improving student achievement

### What standards and curriculum does our school use?

- Georgia Standards of Excellence are used to define the standards taught in grades 7 & 8 English Language Arts, Math, Science and Social Studies.
- Writing across all content areas
- Increased focus on reading in all content areas
- Increased focus on cross-curricular instruction
- Increased focus on how standards relate to the real world (problem-based, project-based, inquiry and STEM)

 Grade 7 -- Georgia Milestones in ELA and Math

Grade 8 -- Georgia Milestones in ELA,
Math, Science and Social Studies

# What is required by law for parent involvement?

#### Professional Qualifications

It is our goal to have highly qualified teachers in every classroom. Because the Pickens County School District is a Strategic Waiver System, we have established the professional qualifications that all teachers must have at the local level.
